  - Two-syllable nonsense words with closed syllables and blends
  - Two-syllable real word with closed syllable ending in -ct
  - Multisyllabic, closed syllable real words
  - Closed syllables with suffix -ed and -ing
- Review of all game board skills
- Color or black game pieces
- 2 blank boards in color
- 2 blank boards in black & white

For this game, you will need:

- Print out the book for game pieces or you can use your own. I also included blank ones if you wanted to color your own.
- You will also need a dice or use an online dice

# Directions

1. Have each player roll to see who goes first
2. On each turn:
  - Roll the dice
  - Move your book or game piece.
  - Read the word using reading strategies or asking for help.
  - More than one person can share a space.
3. The person who gets to finish first, wins!
