 - Multisyllabic words combining syllable types in real words
 - Welded Exceptions: -e in 1-syllable real words
- Review of all game board directions
- 50 or so book game pieces
 - 2 blank boards in color
 - 2 blank boards in black & white

To play the game, you will need:

- Print out the book for game pieces or you can use your own. I also included blank pages if you wanted to color your own.
- You will also need a dice or use an online dice
